# PROTECT YOUR BABY IN THE CAR

## 1. Before Your Baby is Born

Use lap and shoulder belt low and snug



## 3. Making Your Baby Comfortable

Clothing



With Legs and Sleeves



For Snug Harness Fit

## Position of Baby in Car Seat



Back Flat Comfortable



Back Curved Uncomfortable



Support Baby's Head and Body with Rolled Diapers or Blankets

Do Not Wrap Baby in Blanket



Cut Holes in Blanket to Pull Harness Through

## 2. After Your Baby is Born

USE CAR SAFETY SEAT!

NEVER CARRY BABY IN YOUR ARMS



DO NOT USE

Travel Bed



Cloth Carrier

## 4. Common Mistakes

- Infant Facing Forward
- Seat Belt/Harness Not Tight
- Harness Not Used
- Seat Belt Not Used or In the Wrong Place
