GOLF

From 128

Take 95 North or South to 128 North - to Gloucester. Get off on exit 28 - Forest Street/Centennial Drive. Turn left at the top of the exit (head back over 128). Take your first right (very short street). At the stop sign turn left onto Forest Street. First driveway on your right is Salem Country Club.

From points North on 128 Take 128 South to exit 28 - Forest Street/Centennial Drive. At the end of the curve on the exit, take your first left turn (very short street). At the stop sign turn left onto Forest Street. First driveway on your right is Salem Country Club.

From Downtown Boston

US -1 N/I -93 North. Take Route-1 North, Exit 27 (on left toward Tobin Bridge). Follow US-1 N for approximately 13.5 miles. Turn right onto Forest Street and follow to Salem Country Club.
