RE: Board Regulations Effective January 2014

Please forward this information to the Residency Program Directors and administrative staff at your health care facility who participate in physician recruitment for postgraduate training.

INITIAL LIMITED LICENSE EXAMINATION REQUIREMENTS

Effective January 2, 2014, physicians applying for an initial limited license will be required to pass USMLE Step 1 and Step 2, CK and CS, or the first two levels of COMLEX or complete all parts of MCCQE.

FULL LICENSE REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL MEDICAL GRADUATES

Effective January 1, 2014, in order to be eligible for a full license, international medical graduates must complete three (3) years of postgraduate training in an ACGME accredited **or** AOA approved **or** accredited Canadian program. However, in the case of a subspecialty clinical fellowship program, the Board may accept postgraduate training in a hospital that has an ACGME accredited **or** AOA approved **or** accredited Canadian program in the parent specialty.
